## *Minimum System Requirements*

### **Wide-area-network**

- 1000 Mbit/sec Ethernet at the server; switched to subnets
- 100 Mbit/sec Ethernet to each subnet (school)
- 10 Mbit/sec Ethernet to each client (workstation)
- For wireless infrastructure, actual throughput should be measured at the application level, not the manufacturer's hardware specifications.

### **Servers**

- Windows 200x ~ Pentium IV (or better) 1 Ghz ~ 1 GIG RAM
- Web Server: Windows 2003 (Cannot be the domain controller)

### **Workstations**

- PC: Windows 2000 / XP Pro / Vista Business Edition
- Macintosh: G4; Mac OS X 10.4 (or higher)
- Web Classroom requires MS IE 7+ (requires Win XP+) or Firefox V 2+

### **Palm OS PDA**

- Palm™ OS 5.4.9 or better (e.g., Tungsten-level Palm for PDA Office, Zire-level Palm for PDA Classroom/Gradebook)

### **Laser Printer**

### **Data Backup**
